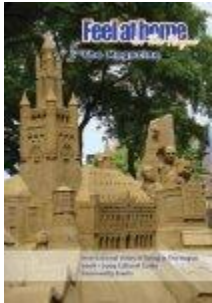


# Feel at home in The Hague
